## ManpowerGroup Employment Outlook Survey: Job prospects remain stable at the beginning of new year according Italian employers

Hiring intentions remain relatively stable both quarter-over-quarter and year-over-year.

Restaurants & Hotels and Agriculture & Fishing sector employers report the most optimistic hiring intentions.

**Milan, December 13**<sup>th</sup> **2016** – According to ManpowerGroup's latest Employment Outlook, published today, hiring activity will remain relatively stable throughout the first three months of the new year. From January to March, 3% of employers anticipating an increase in staffing levels, 5% forecasting a decrease and 90% expecting no change. Once the data is adjusted to allow for seasonal variation, the Outlook stands at 0%. Hiring intentions remain relatively stable both quarter-over-quarter and year-over-year.

"While the official unemployment rate has crept up recently and economic conditions remain challenging, our survey reveals a transition in the labour markets, with weaker employment conditions in Mining & Quarrying offset by more positive conditions in industries such as Restaurants & Hotels "Stefano Scabbio, President Mediterranean and Eastern Europe says. "Employers should keep on changing and transforming their working models, as to be competitive on the market. As a consequence of these fast changes, we expect an increase in demand for specialised and new skillsets that can support future growth. The need for a global approach to talent acquisition and the ability to access quality local talent has become a key success criterion. Employers realise that they need to invest in managing global talent pools to create a real and sustainable competitive advantage".

## Regional comparisons

Employers in two of the four regions forecast some payroll gains in 1Q 2017, with Net Employment Outlooks of +3% and +1% reported in the North West and the North East, respectively. However, staffing levels are expected to decline in Middle Italy, where the Outlook stands at -3%, and in the South/Islands, with an Outlook of -4%. Quarter-over-quarter, hiring intentions are 3 percentage points weaker in both Middle Italy and the South/Islands. However, employers in the North West report a slight improvement of 2 percentage points while the Outlook for the North East remains relatively stable.

## **Sector comparisons**

Staffing levels are expected to decline in six of the 10 industry sectors during 1Q 2017. Employers in the Mining & Quarrying sector report the weakest Net Employment Outlook of -15%, while labor markets are forecast to struggle in both the Public & Social sector and the Transport, Storage & Communication sector, with Outlooks of -6%. Meanwhile, employers in three sectors expect to grow payrolls, with the strongest hiring prospects reported for the Restaurants & Hotels sector,

where the Outlook stands at +8%. Job gains are also anticipated in the Agriculture, Hunting, Forestry & Fishing sector and the Wholesale & Retail Trade sector, with Outlooks of +5% and +4%, respectively.

## **Organization-Size comparisons**

Employers in all four organization size categories expect to grow staffing levels during the next three months. Large employers (250 or more employees) report cautiously optimistic hiring plans for the upcoming quarter with a Net Employment Outlook of +10%, while some job gains are also anticipated by Small (10-49 employees) employers who report an Outlook of +2%. Meanwhile, Medium (50-249 employees) employers report flat hiring prospects with an Outlook of 0% and Micro (less than 10 employees), employers expect a decline in staffing levels, reporting an Outlook of -2%. When compared with the previous quarter, hiring plans are 3 percentage points weaker for Micro employers and decline by 2 percentage points in the Large-size employer category. Elsewhere, Small employers report no change while the Outlook for Medium employers remains relatively stable.
